Canisius College offers residence life at its best. We want our students to feel at home on campus. As a result, we offer students a wide variety of accommodations so they can choose the living situation that is best for them. Take a look for yourself!

First-Year Housing

Bosch and Frisch Halls, as well as the newly-opened Eastwood Hall, are the primary residences for first-year students at Canisius. All three halls feature suite style living; Bosch and Frisch also offer traditional double rooms.

Apartments and Townhouses

The Delavan, Village, Main/Delavan, Main/Humboldt Townhouses and Griffin Hall are townhouse complexes and apartments for sophomores, juniors and seniors. Each comes with a private bathroom and fully equipped kitchen. Two, three, four and five person apartments are available; Delavan Townhouses feature all single bedrooms.

Specialty Housing

Students in the All-College Honors Program may apply to live in George Martin Honors Hall, which features single and double rooms, two living room areas and a large kitchen. Champion Hall, also known as the Intercultural Living Center, is available for students who wish to be a part of a learning community residence for international and U.S. students.

- Approximately 75 percent of Canisius' college housing has been renovated or built new in the last eight years.
- First-year students living in Bosch, Frisch or Eastwood Hall benefit from having direct access to the convenient walkway tunnel system that provides indoor access from the residence halls to classrooms, the library, the dining hall, the bookstore, the health and counseling center, and many other campus locations.
- All on-campus housing at Canisius features cable television access, high speed Internet access, local telephone service with voice mail and use of campus laundry facilities at no extra charge.
- A campus shuttle system operates from dusk to 2:00 a.m. each day to provide students with point-to-point transportation service.

- The Upper Deck is great for late-night snacks in a sports lounge theme, featuring Buffalo wings, burgers, fresh salads and subs, all made-to-order.




get involved
